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## Order of Fee fixation for the Post graduate Courses in Medical and Dentel Colleges for the year 2017-18

- 1. The Fee Regulatory Committee (Medical) (hereinafter referred to as "the Committee") has been constituted under section-9 of the Gujarat Professional Medical Educational Colleges or Institutions (Regulation of Admission and Fixation of Fees) Act, 2007, Act 3 of 2008(hereinafter referred to as "the Act") enacted by the State Government to make special provision, inter-alia, for fixation of fees in professional medical education colleges or institutions and for matters connected therewith or incidental thereto.
- Section-2(h) of the Act defines "Management Seats". It means twenty five per cent scats of the professional courses of the total approved seats in the unaided colleges or institutions including fifteen per cent Non-Resident Indian scats.
- 3. On 26th August 2016, the Government of Gujarat passed the Gujarat Professional Medical Educational Colleges or Institutions ( (Regulation of Admission and Fixation of Fees! (Amendment) Act 2016(Gujarat Act 13 of 2016) amending section 2(i) of the Principal Act and retaining the original provision of

15% NRI seats in respect of only genuine NRI / NRI proper i.e. children or wards of the Non-Resident Indian. In view of this amendment all the medical and dental institutions submitted proposals for re-fixation of management quota fee of post graduate courses so as to avoid any loss being caused to them on account of the amendment.

- 4. The Committee took in to consideration all the proposals of the Medical as well as Dental Colleges for re-fixation of the management quota fees. While refixing the fees for the Management Quota, the Committee kept in view the fact that very few admissions of the NRI of the categories mentioned in the amended provision are taken in the Self Financed Institutions in Gujarat State and refixed the fee for the year 2017-18 accordingly to see that no financial loss is caused to the institutions
- 5. The fees indicated in annexed sheet includes all types and kind of fees such as Tuition Fees, Clinical, Library, Laboratory, Computer Centre, Gymkhana, Internet, Sports and Recreation and Self / Personality Centers etc except Hostel fee and Transportation fee. As such the college is advised not to collect any other fee from the students except the fees as mentioned in Annexure attached here with. Any such unauthorized collection of fee may invite punative action as per the law.
- The Committee also recommends the colleges to devise the fee structure providing for differential fee for the degree / diploma courses, but the average

fee from the all the courses and all the students should not exceed, the fee indicated in the Annexed sheet.

7. The fee structure determined by this Committee shall be binding for the year 2017-18. The fees so determined shall be applicable to only new students admitted in that specific academic year and shall not be revised till the completion of their professional course in that college or institution i.e. the students admitted in the year 2017-18, the fees of 2017-18 are applicable to those students up to the completion of their course.

It is made clear that if any management seat remains vacant or the institution surrenders the management seats to the Government for admission, in that case fee would be at par with the government seats.

- The College / institution is also advised to comply with following additional conditions:
  - a. The College shall not take fees for the full course at the time of admission. The fees should be collected per semester / term of 6 (Six) months as the case may be.
  - b. In view of cost of securing bank guarantee, the College should, as far as possible, refrain from insisting on bank guarantee. The Committee advises that the College should work out an alternate form of security/guarantee to

ensure that no student once admitted, abandons the course half way resulting into loss of opportunity for others. In this background, the college is free to work out an arrangement to ensure that the student leaving the course before completion pays the full amount of the Course for the entire term of two or three years as the case may be.

- c. The College shall not force on the students, any facility including hostel and transport as part of the condition for admission or its continuity till the end of the full tenure of the course.
- d. The College shall notify the fee structure on the College Notice Board and display copy of this order on its Mandatory Disclosure Link on its web site.
- e. The College will be free to fix fees for NRI students up to 15 % of the intake capacity subject to intimation of the same to the Fee Committee. The difference of amount of the fees from the NRI category students and Management students shall be used by the institution for providing scholarship to the students and/or increasing infrastructure facilities. The institute shall also furnish all the information pertaining to the utilization of excess fees from the NRI category students as per the Information Memorandum submitted by the institute to the Fee Regulatory Committee in the next block of three years.


- f. The College is advised to work out a financial aid scheme through which it shall provide waiver or relief or concession in fees to the students belonging to weaker section of the society.
- 11. This order has been made under section 10 of the Act hence violation of any of the provisions contained in it will render the management of the institution liable to be proceeded against under section 14 of the Act
